Community Grants and future projects

We have allocated £200 for community grants in this financial year. This has not been publicised as we have no grant awarding policy or processes for awarding grants in place.

If we are to continue with this there are questions we need to answer:

- Who or what are we seeking to benefit?
- How will we and others make this happen? need simple application form and publicity
- How will we know that we are being successful (monitoring and evaluation)?
- Are there priorities for support?
- Who is eligible?
 - How will we assess the applicant organisation?
 - What won't we fund?
- Is there a maximum amount that can be applied for?
 - How and how often should we review our progress?

Background

Any money available as grants (or for any other purpose) has to be raised from the precept (the small addition to Council Tax which is our only income and allows us to function as a Parish Council)

Last year we set the precept at £7050

An additional sum of £200 will be set aside for the Council to make grants to any organisations in the Villages that are deserving of the Council financial support.

It was RESOLVED that the Council Precept for the Financial Year 2025/2026 be set at £7050. This will result in an annual payment of £28.75 for a Band D property. Previous year the payment was £29.03

The precept to Band D Council tax (which legislation considers to be typical) calculation is as follows:-

Littleham/Landcross Precept divided the estimated council tax base = Band D for the year

Precept set at £7050 / 245.23 = £28.75

therefore each **extra £1,000** we might want to raise translates to £4.08 extra per year for a Band D property. (£1000/245.23)

and each £100 translates to 41 pence per year for a band D.

With the above calculation you can estimate the effects of any level of precept. I say estimate as the Council Tax Base is recalculated annually and will vary a bit. If there has been property growth in the parish then the base should increase and the precept stays the same then the parish element of council tax will reduce.

For information, the table below shows what other parishes raise as their precept

Parishes are difficult to compare due to factors not shown in the cold figures, geographic size, sparsity, proximity to neighbouring towns/villages etc. etc.

Questions:

Should we continue with the idea of community grants?

Should we think of bigger projects which could be funded through the Parish Council via the precept?

Do we need to consult with the community before changing the precept? If so how and how quickly could we do this?
